

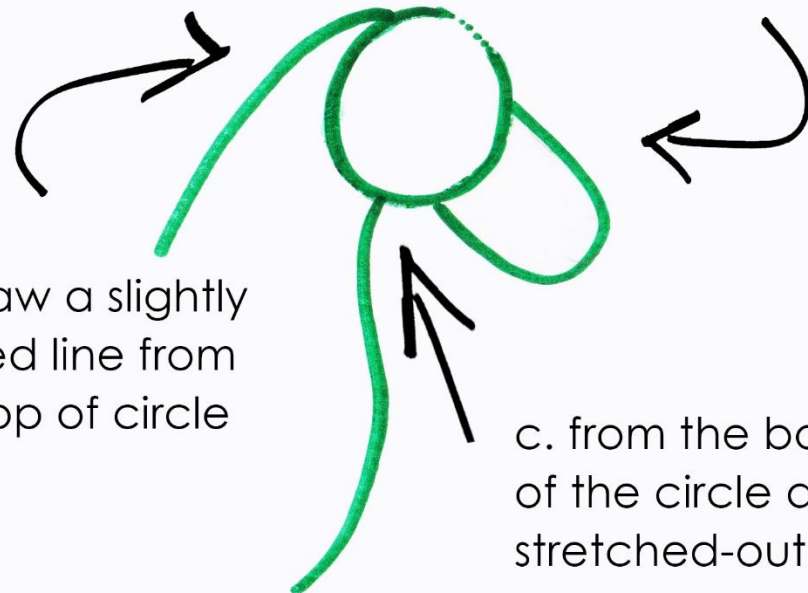
The Chinese Unicorn

Traditionally known as the Qi-Lin or Ki-Rin

Beliefs from Asian mythology:

A creature of pure peace and wisdom, a Qi-Lin is only known to appear during times of world peace. With a body of a deer and dragon scales, the tail of an ox and a flowing, fluffy mane - they are stunning! Holy fire is said to glow around the animal and folklore states when they are seen, this means a great world leader is coming!

a.) start with the circle, and add a sideways letter 'U'



b. draw a slightly curved line from the top of circle

c. from the bottom of the circle draw a stretched-out 'S'

3 steps left!

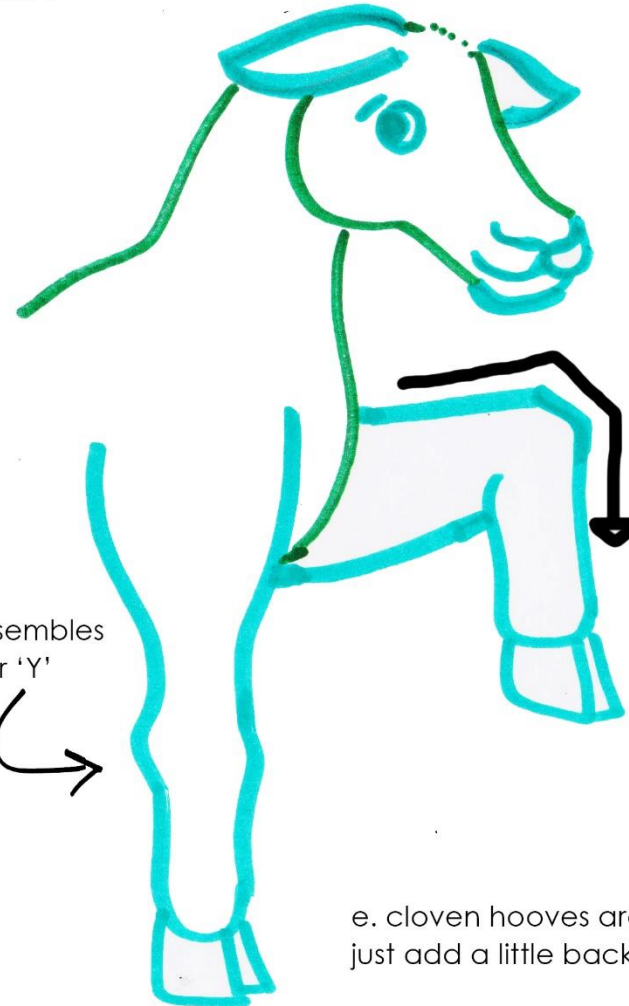

a. add in the leaf-shaped ears and the cute eye!



b. think of their nose as a wavy 'T', their mouth as a wide, lower-case 'w' and their chin as wide 'u'

c. watch the three angle changes on the top lines of the lifted leg

d. this leg resembles a wavy letter 'Y'

e. cloven hooves are easy to draw! just add a little backwards 'L' !

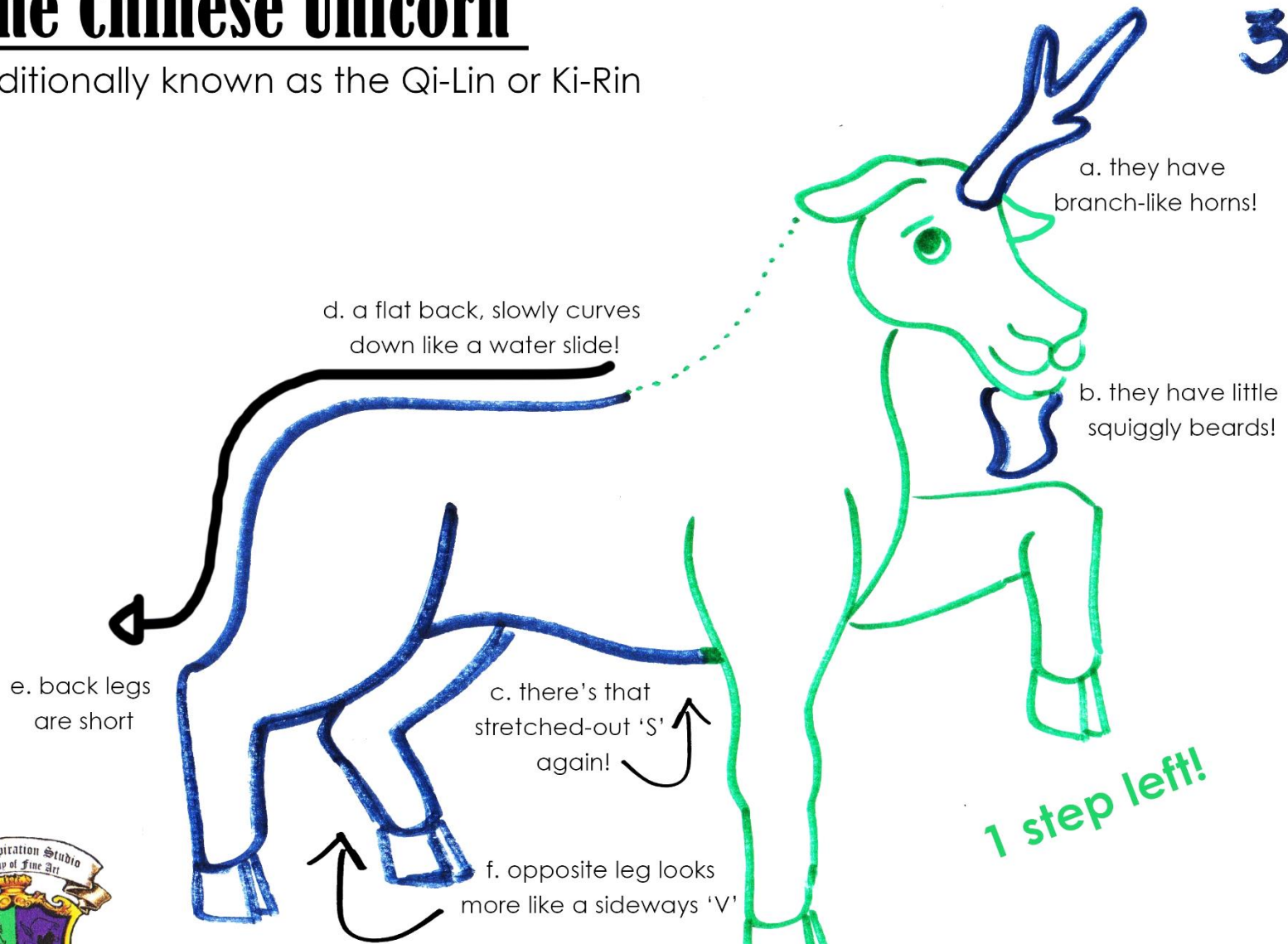

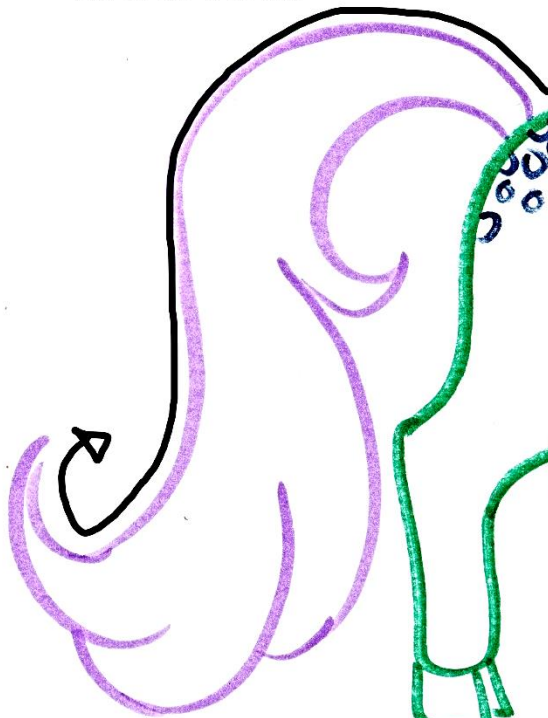

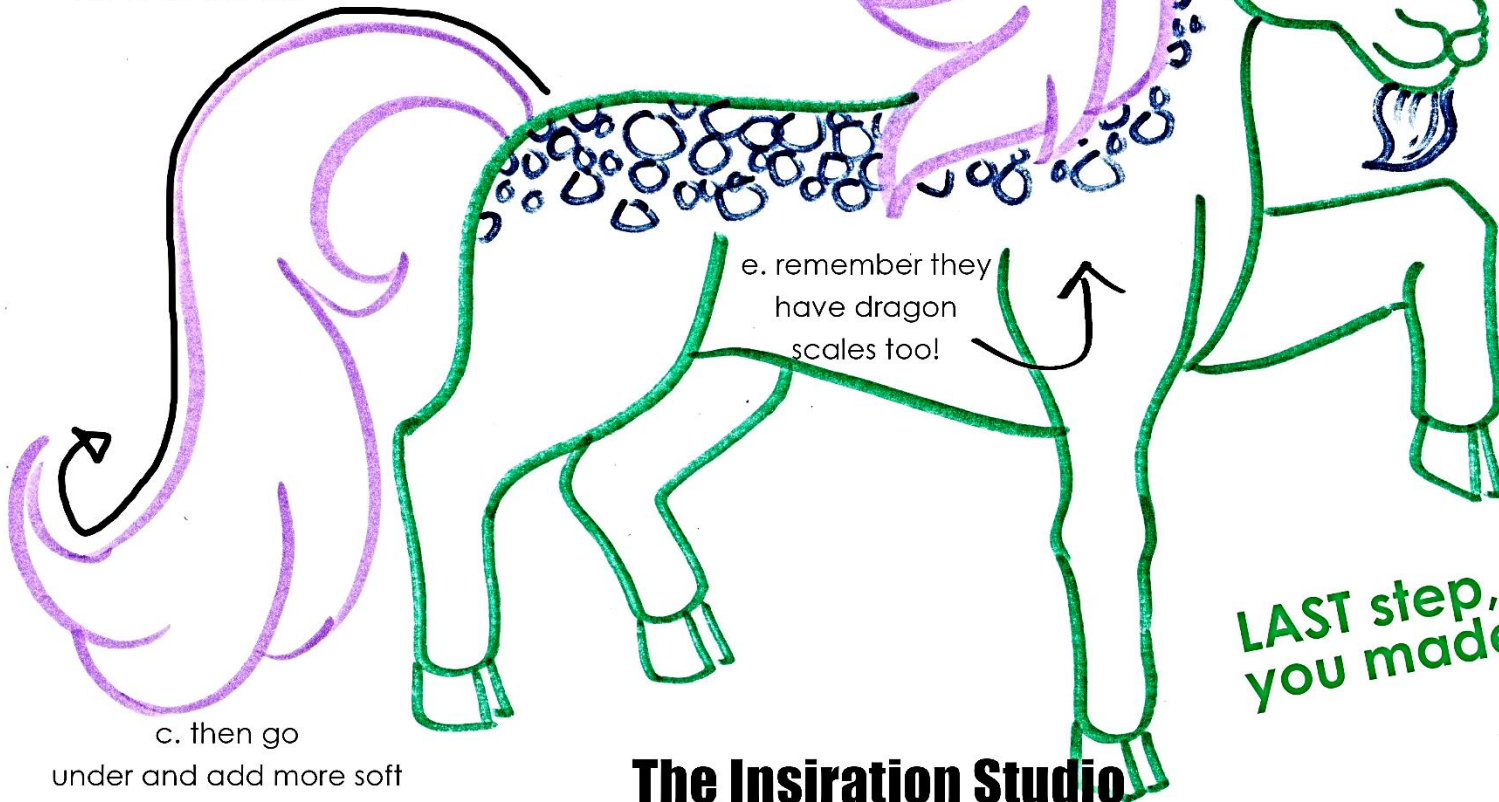

b. start with one flowing curve for the tail



c. then go under and add more soft and overlapping curves!



e. remember they have dragon scales too!

a. adding the mane is like adding waves of fire... just make sure they are rounded and not spiky!
